"End Times, the Final Judgment, and Christ's Return in Glory: Exploring the Bible's Witness to These Realities"

Question: What comfort does the return of Christ "to judge the living and the dead" give you? Answer: That in all affliction and persecution I may await with head held high the very Judge from heaven who has already submitted himself to the judgment of God for me and has removed all the cure from me; that he will cast all his enemies and mine into everlasting condemnation, but he shall take me, together with all his elect, to himself into heavenly joy and glory. -- The Heidelberg Catechism, Question 52

s a general rule, the subject is one that creates exceeding discomfort -particularly for genteel, buttoned-down believers. The polite inclination is to
leave any discussions of what the Bible teaches about the end times to a fringe
group preoccupied by all those messy details like Christ's promised return, the Final
Judgment, and the separation of the good from the evil in history's final reckoning.

But if such discussions are only left to the fringe, only the fringe element of **Christianity gets** a voice in interpreting and explaining what the Bible teaches about the promises of the End. That would be a mistake. From the teachings of Jesus in the



gospels to the writings of Paul and the witness of the book of Daniel -- not to mention other places in our Old Testament -- there is a firm conviction in regards to the linear movement of history and a point where our human reckoning of time is brought to a close with God's final judgment.

The September TIM Talks takes on this important topic. We will look at the importance of understanding the end and the teachings of Scripture that surround this subject -- whether that witness is from one of the minor prophets (as brief as the little book of Joel is, it has plenty to tell us about end times) to the teachings of the gospels. Jesus has a lot to say in response to his disciples' question: "Tell us, when will this be, and what will be the sign that all these things are about to be accomplished?"
